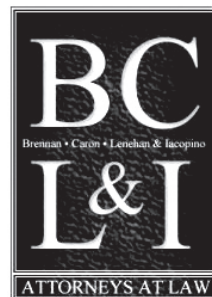

The Concord Criterium is the New England Regional Championship Race. One-day licensees are not eligible for medals. New England Regional Championship Medals will be awarded in all age group categories: All Junior categories; Men under 23, 23-34, 35-44, 45-54, 55-64, 65+, Cat.1/2, Cat.3, Cat. 4, Cat. 5 u35, Cat. 5 35+; and Women Cat. 1/2, Cat.3, Cat. 4, 35+, 45+.

****Races shall only be open to New England riders (as listed on their 2006 racing license).****

USA Cycling Rules apply in ALL races. ANSI/Snell Approved Helmets Required. No straight bars except for Juniors 10-12. No aero bars. No sleeveless jerseys. For a complete list of rules please see www.usacycling.org.
